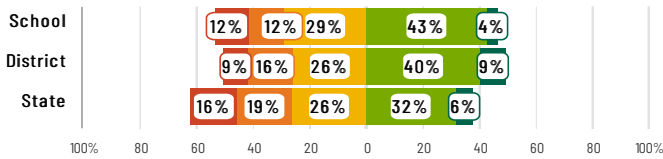

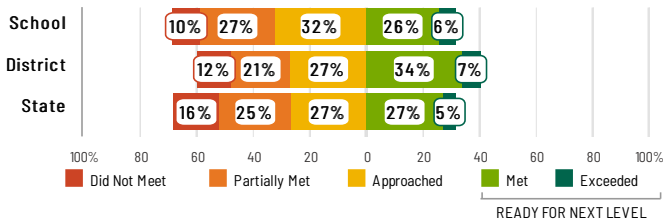
Academic Success

English Language Arts



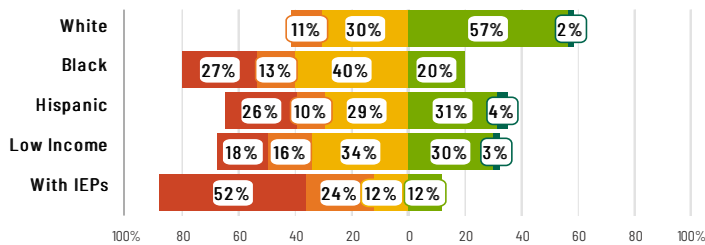

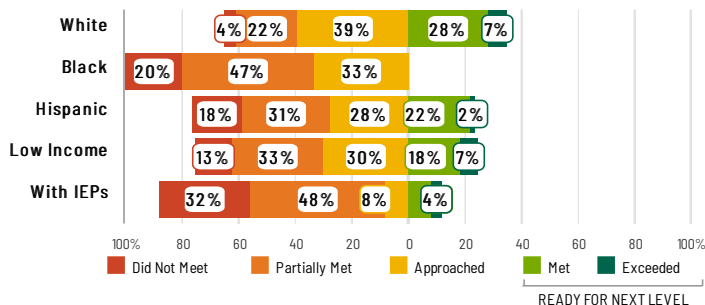
Success by Student Group

Percentage of students who miss 10% or more of school days per year either with or without a valid excuse



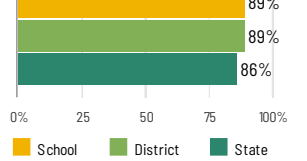
Student Mobility

Academic Courses

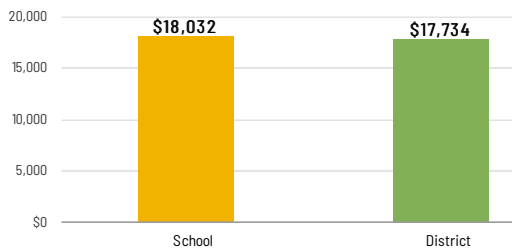

School-Level Finance
