Dear Parents/Guardians of 6th Grade Students:

Prevention educators from the YWCA will be presenting a Child Assault Prevention (CAP) Program to 6th grade students during their Physical Development and Health classes soon. The CAP Program focuses on three components:

1. **Bullying:** Students will learn about the importance of being respected and respecting others, options victims have, and the role that bystanders have in preventing bullying.
2. **Stranger Assault:** Students will learn about listening to their instincts, some self-defense techniques, and what to do if approached by a stranger.
3. **Known Adult Assault:** Students will learn that their body is their own, the difference between good and bad secrets, and what to do if someone they know and trust hurts them.

Throughout the program, we will help students identify a safety network of adults that they can go to if they have any problems or concerns.
