Dear Community Member,



Thank you for your continuing support for Community Consolidated School District 93 (CCSD93) as we seek to maximize the academic, social and emotional potential of each student. Because of you, we are able to offer a wide range of programs and services to meet the diverse needs of our 3,350 preschool through 8th grade students,

who come to us from portions of Bloomingdale, Carol Stream and Hanover Park, across our Early Childhood Center, six elementary schools and two middle schools. Here are a few timely updates from CCSD93 for you.

D93 Schools Continue to Improve Proficiency, Receive High Marks From State Board of Education

The Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) recently released its School Report Cards with data from the 2023-24 school year. They provide easily understandable breakdowns of how well our schools are progressing on a number of educational goals and give thorough data on each school's student and staff populations as well as financial information. In them, each elementary and middle school in the state receives a summative designation from ISBE, which takes into account a variety of measures related to school performance and growth.

I'm very proud to share that:

- Heritage Lakes Elementary School has earned the designation of Exemplary, which means that its performance is in the top 10% of Illinois schools.
- All other CCSD93 middle and elementary schools have earned the designation of Commendable, the second highest designation that the state awards.

These designations indicate that all of our schools, including demographic subgroups within each school, are performing above state-established thresholds for success.

One of the key measures of the School Report Cards is proficiency. This is derived from Illinois Assessment of Readiness (IAR) scores for English language arts and math, taken by students in grades 3-8, and Illinois Science Assessment (ISA) scores for science, taken by students in grades 5 and 8. As a continuous improvement organization, I am happy to report that CCSD93 experienced proficiency gains from 2022-23 to 2023-24 as follows:


- English Language Arts: +6.0%
- Math: +2.5%
- Science: + 3.7%

While these gains are positive, there is always more room for improvement. CCSD93 administrators and educators are working through the School Report Card data to identify areas of focus to increase student achievement. Dashboard Measures Strategic Plan Progress

CCSD93 is in the second year of a five-year, 2023-2028 Strategic Plan, which identifies the district's values, priorities and objectives for the next five years based on feedback from students, parents, staff and community members. We have developed a variety of important data points, referred to as key performance indicators (KPIs), to be measured annually in order to track our progress toward achieving the plan's objectives.
