

Stratford Middle School Improvement Plan 2023-24

Data Analysis Our Instructional Team reviewed the following data and identified our celebrations, as well as our opportunities for improvement.

Data Sources:

- ECRA/iReady
- 5Essentials
- Satisfaction Survey

Celebrations:

- Based on ECRA data, 86% of students met or exceeded expected growth in Reading in Fall 2022
- Based on ECRA data, 87% of students met or exceeded expected growth (growth target) in Math in Fall of 2022
- Based on 5Essentials data, Collaborative Practices (67) +29 (teacher responses); Math Instruction (67) +16 (student responses) and Teacher to Teacher Trust (62) +19 (teacher responses).

Opportunities for Improvement:

- Per iReady, as of Spring 2022 48% of Math students were performing below grade level
- Per iReady, As of Spring 2022, 56% of Reading students were performing below grade level
- Based on 5Essentials data, student teacher trust dropped 22 points from 2020-21 to 2021-22.

Student Performance Target Goals

1. Greater than 84% of students will demonstrate expected or higher than expected growth in All Subjects (ELA, Reading and Math) according to the ECRA Overall Growth Summary.
2. Outperform our IAR projected proficiency target identified in the ECRA Spring IAR Projected Proficiency Report.
3. On the District Strategic Plan Survey, at least 75% of students will agree or strongly agree that their social and emotional needs are being addressed.
