

COMMUNITY RELATIONS

Community Organizations

The School District has the primary responsibility for the formal education of the students of the District. However, the Board recognizes that many governmental agencies and community organizations, while not primarily concerned with formal education, play an important role in education.

The Board shall endeavor to establish positive working relationships with public and private organizations which contribute to the education process and to the general welfare of the citizens of the community. The Superintendent or designee shall serve as liaison between the District and those community organizations, and shall report to the Board concerning any relevant communications, contacts, and activities between the District and such organizations.
