

COMMUNITY RELATIONS

Booster Organizations

All booster organizations are entities separate and distinct from the School District, and are neither operated nor controlled by the School District.

Booster organization activities can be a valuable means of stimulating interest in the objectives and achievements of the District. Productive actions initiated by booster clubs should provide a positive relationship between the community and the schools.

The Building Leadership Team will collaborate with booster organizations regarding plans and endeavors to be undertaken by such organizations.

All booster clubs' proposed projects shall be evaluated by the Building Leadership Team in terms of their overall value to the curricular and co-curricular programs of the District. A project's total value to all the school's students shall be the primary consideration of the Building Leadership Team.

No booster organization shall represent itself as being part of or affiliated with District 93 in such a manner as to suggest that the organization is sponsored, governed or directed by the Board of Education.
