

## COMMUNITY RELATIONS

### PROHIBITION OF TOBACCO, CANNABIS, OR VAPOR INHALANT USE ON SCHOOL DISTRICT PROPERTY

The use of tobacco cannabis, electronic cigarettes/vaping or any non-medical inhalant devices is prohibited on the school property of School District 93. This prohibition will apply to such property before, during and after the regular school day and on days when school is not in session.

For purposes of this policy, the term "tobacco" will mean any substance containing tobacco leaf, including but not limited to cigarettes, cigars, pipe tobacco, snuff, chewing tobacco or dipping tobacco, and any nicotine delivery systems other than those prescribed by a physician.

The term "cannabis" includes marijuana, hashish and other substances which are identified as including any parts of the plant Cannabis Sativa, whether growing or not, the seeds thereof, the resin extracted from any part of such plant, and any compound manufacture, sale, derivative, mixture or preparation of such plant, its seeds or resin, including tetrahydrocannabinol (THC) and all other cannabinol derivatives, including its naturally occurring or synthetically produced ingredients, whether produced directly or indirectly by extraction, or independently by means of chemical synthesis or by a combination of extraction and chemical synthesis, but does not include the mature stalks of such plant, fiber produced from such stalks, oil or cake made from the seeds of such plant, any other compound, manufacture, salt, derivative, mixture or preparation of such mature stalk (except the resin extracted therefrom), fiber oil cake or the sterilized seed of such plant which is incapable of germination. Cannabis does not include industrial hemp as defined and authorized under the Industrial Hemp Act. (720 ILCS 550/3).

Electronic cigarettes/vaping device will mean any device that employs a battery or other mechanism to heat a solution or substance to produce a vapor or aerosol intended for inhalation; any cartridge or container of a solution or substance intended to be used with or in the device or to refill the device; or any solution or substance, whether or not it contains nicotine intended for use in the device.

For purposes of this policy, the term "school property" will include, without limitation, any area within a building or other indoor facility used for school purposes, and the areas outside of such buildings and facilities, whether owned, leased or contracted for by the District, including parking areas. "School property" will also include all vehicles owned, leased or operated by School District 93.

Also, in this policy, the term "school purposes" includes all events, activities or other uses of school property authorized or permitted by the Board of Education or District officials. Such events, activities and other uses include -- without limitation -- all interscholastic and extracurricular athletic, academic and other events sponsored by the Board or in which District students participate.

Groups requesting use of school buildings in the District shall be advised of this policy and shall be required to adhere to it.
