

COMMUNITY RELATIONSCorrespondence

When the Board President or Superintendent receives a written correspondence from a resident within the school district requesting the consideration of a matter before the Board, the person shall receive a written reply from an appointed official of the Board. The reply from the District shall be given to the person no later than sixty (60) days following receipt of the request.

Included in the Board's response shall be either a time, date, and place for the person to appear before the Board or a list of reasons for denying the person's appearance before the Board.
