### News Media Relations

The news media represents the public interest in reporting information concerning the District's schools. It is in the interest of both the educational community and the citizens/taxpayers of the District that there be free and open communications with the news media.

Individuals should channel outgoing information to the media through the Superintendent's Office. Individuals contacted by the news media should exercise discretion and respond within the realm and scope of their personal responsibility and knowledge. Individuals should not attempt to answer for others or discuss topics with which they are not familiar, or topics which are outside their scope of responsibility.
