

COMMUNITY RELATIONS

Public Conduct on School Property

In order to maintain public order on real property owned, leased, or otherwise used by the School District, the Board of Education requires that no person on school property (including visitors, students, and employees) shall perform any of the following acts:

1. Strike, injure, threaten, harass, or intimidate a staff member, student, Board member, sports official or coach, or any other person.
2. Damage or threaten to damage the property of another or of the School District.
3. Violate any provision of the penal law of the State of Illinois, or ordinance of the municipality where the real property is located or the County of DuPage.
4. Smoke or otherwise use tobacco products, cannabis, or electronic cigarettes/vaping or any non-medical inhalant devices on the school property of School District 93 when such property is being used for any purpose. This prohibition shall apply to such property before, during, and after the regular school day and on days when school is not in session.
5. Consume, possess, distribute, or be under the influence of alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs; be present when the person's alcohol or illegal drug consumption is detectable, regardless of when and/or where the use occurred.
6. Use or possess medical cannabis.
7. Except as specifically permitted by State or Federal law, possess a weapon, any object that can reasonably be considered a weapon or looks like a weapon, or any dangerous device.
8. Conduct himself/herself in such a manner as to impede, delay, or otherwise interfere with the orderly conduct of the educational program of the School District or any other activity taking place on school property which has been authorized by the Board of Education, the Superintendent, a Building Principal, or any other authorized School District administrator (including using cellular phones in a disruptive manner).
9. Enter upon any portion of school premises at any time for purposes other than those that are lawful and/or authorized by the Board.
10. Willfully violate other rules or regulations adopted by the Board of Education, or a directive from an authorized security officer or District employee.
11. Operate a motor vehicle: (a) in a risky manner, (b) in excess of 20 miles per hour, or (c) in violation of an authorized District employee's directive.

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"School property" means within District and school buildings, grounds, and parking areas; in vehicles used for school purpose; and any location used for a School Board meeting, school athletic event, or other school-sponsored event.

As circumstances warrant, appropriate action will be taken by the District's administrators.
