BOARD RELATIONSHIPS - STANDING COMMITTEES

Standing committees may be appointed by the Board President subject to approval by the Board. Committee members will be appointed for two years. Such committee members shall make periodic reports to the Board.

Standing committees have the power to research, investigate, and make suggestions to the Board, but the ultimate authority to make decisions will continue to reside with the Board.

Board committee meetings are designed to be working sessions for committee members. Therefore, all material relating to committee work is the property of the committee until presented to the Board of Education. Committee meetings are structured for public attendance but not for public participation. The committee may invite segments of the community to interact on specific committee topics.

Board members may be appointed to any of the standing committees.

Committee meetings may be called by the Board President or the Superintendent.
