

BOARD OF EDUCATIONBOARD MEMBERS - BOARD MEMBER QUALIFICATIONS

In order to be qualified to be a School Board member, a person must be, on the date of his or her election: 1) a citizen of the United States, 2) eighteen (18) years of age or older, 3) a resident of the State of Illinois and of the District for at least one year immediately preceding his or her election, 4) a registered voter, and 5) neither a school trustee nor a school treasurer. A School Board candidate/member must also file an economic interest statement as required by the Illinois Governmental Ethics Act.
