

BOARD OF EDUCATIONBOARD MEMBERS - SCHOOL DISTRICT ELECTIONS

School Board elections are governed by the general election laws of the State of Illinois. School Board members are elected at the consolidated election held on the first Tuesday in April of odd-numbered years. The School Board's election duties are:

1. By proper resolution, to place public policy propositions or advisory questions of public policy on the ballot;
2. To select the School Board Secretary to serve as the local election official. He or she receives petitions for the submission of a public question to referenda and forwards them to the proper election officer and otherwise provides information to the community concerning District elections.

Petitions nominating a citizen and resident of the District to the office of Board Member must be signed by at least fifty (50) registered voters or 10% of the total number of registered voters in the District, whichever is less, and filed with the DuPage County Board of Election Commissioners.
