

STUDENTSACTIVITIES - STUDENT FUND RAISING ACTIVITIES

The Board of Education recognizes that participation of students under faculty supervision in the process of planning and obtaining financial support for their own activities may be desirable as part of the educational process.

Funds raised through student efforts shall be subject to the control of the Building Principal with the advice and consent of the sponsors. Fund raising plans approved by the Building Principal shall be submitted to the Superintendent for approval. The funds shall be used to the maximum extent possible for the educational, recreational or cultural purposes for which they were designed to serve.

The use of students to promote fund raising activities of parent groups or other non-school sponsored groups shall generally be discouraged except in the case of activities pre-approved by the Building Principal which are of a school-wide nature in which participation can be a positive experience for students and when the proceeds contribute to a recognized humanitarian purpose.

Fund raising, when conducted, shall be on a school-wide basis as much as possible.
