WELFARE SERVICES - BICYCLE USE

It is the responsibility of the student's parent(s)/guardian(s) to determine whether the student can ride his or her bicycle to school. It is also the responsibility of the student's parent(s)/guardian(s) to provide for the safety and protection of that student to and from school on his or her bicycle.

Parents who allow their children to ride bicycles to school should ensure that their children:

- Follow Illinois Bicycle Rules of the Road
- Take a safe route to school
- Ride with a friend or sibling whenever possible
- Wear safety helmets and appropriate clothing

Bicycles brought to school must be stored in the bicycle racks provided by the District, and must be properly secured and locked.

Bicycle riding on the school playground is prohibited. Those students who do not exhibit cycling courtesy or who do not follow District safety rules shall be prohibited by the Building Principal from riding their bicycle to school. A letter will be sent from the Building Principal to the student's parent(s)/guardian(s) explaining the reasons for denial of this privilege to the student.
