

STUDENTSWELFARE SERVICES - ANIMAL BITES

If a child is bitten or scratched by an animal, either at school or on the way to or from school, the police shall be called at once and every effort shall be made to assist in identifying the animal so that the animal can be captured by the police and the necessary procedures with regard to rabies can be followed. The parent(s)/guardian(s) of the child shall also be notified so that the child may be taken to a physician.
