

STUDENTSWELFARE SERVICES - EXEMPTION FROM PHYSICAL ACTIVITY

A student may be exempted from some or all physical activities for up to three (3) days when the appropriate excuses are submitted to the school by parent(s)/guardian(s), or in excess of three (3) days when appropriate excuses are submitted to the school by a person licensed under the Medical Practice Act.

Special activities in physical education will be provided for students whose physical or emotional condition, as determined by a person licensed under the Medical Practice Act, prevents their participation in regular physical education courses.
