

STUDENTSWELFARE SERVICES - PSYCHOLOGICAL TESTING

Educational and psychological testing services are available to students in the District through specialists on the staff as determined appropriate by the special services team. These services are available at no cost to parent(s)/guardian(s). The services of a Social Worker are also available to students and parent(s)/guardian(s) desiring help in alleviating emotional and/or behavioral difficulties.

Through use of these services a teacher may be better able to design appropriate learning experiences. In some instances the need for specialized programs or referrals to other resources may be indicated.

In all cases, written permission to administer a psychological examination must be obtained from the parent(s)/guardian(s). Upon completion of the examination, the results will be interpreted to the parent(s)/guardian(s) as well as the professional staff.
