

STUDENTSWELFARE SERVICES - PSYCHOLOGICAL AND SOCIAL SERVICES

The services of a psychologist, social worker, and/or counselors are provided by the Board of Education. Psychologists, social workers, and counselors help create a climate in the schools which encourages every child to make optimum use of the educational opportunities provided. For those children whose functioning within the school setting is limited because of social or emotional problems and/or skill deficits, the psychologist, social worker, and counselors provide counseling, either individually or in groups, as well as consultation with staff.

Since parent/guardian understanding and cooperation are vital to the success of the work, the informed consent of the parents/guardians is secured in advance. Close contact with parents/guardians is also maintained, both to give and receive information.
