

STUDENTSRIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES - RECIPROCAL REPORTING OF CRIMINAL OFFENSES COMMITTED BY STUDENTS

The Parent-Teacher Advisory Committee for School District 93, in cooperation with local law enforcement agencies, shall assist the Board in developing guidelines and administrative procedures necessary to establish and maintain a reciprocal reporting system between the District and local law enforcement agencies regarding criminal offenses committed by students. The Parent-Teacher Advisory Committee shall be comprised of parents, teachers and may also include students. Community representatives, including persons from business, industry, and public service may also serve on the Committee. Members shall be individuals who have shown an interest in District educational issues and who are willing to commit time to committee work.
