RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES - AGENCY AND POLICE INTERROGATION

Protection of the student's rights shall be balanced with the District's responsibility to cooperate with local police and agency officials in the officials' investigation of unlawful activities. Inherent in the process of cooperation is recognition of the function of the schools and respect for the constitutional rights of students.

All requests by police or agency officials to interview a student shall be handled according to the procedures for the interrogation of students developed by the Superintendent. Parents should be contacted as soon as reasonably possible when police or agency officials are officially involved in a case.
