### ASSIGNMENT AND ADMISSION - PART-TIME ATTENDANCE BY PRIVATE OR PAROCHIAL STUDENTS

The District will accept private or parochial students who live within the District for part-time attendance in the District's regular education program, provided there is sufficient space in the school. Requests for part-time attendance for the following school year must be submitted by the non-public school Principal before May 1. Transportation for such students shall be governed by Section 29-4 of the Illinois School Code.

The District will also accept for part-time attendance those students with disabilities who live within the District and are enrolled in nonpublic schools. Requests must be submitted by the student's parent(s)/guardian(s). Special educational services shall be provided to such students as soon as possible after the identification, evaluation, and placement procedures provided by state law, but no later than the beginning of the next school semester following the completion of such procedures. Transportation for students in part-time attendance shall be provided only if required in the student's individualized educational program on the basis of the student's disabling condition or as the special education program location may require.
