ASSIGNMENT AND ADMISSION - SCHOOL ATTENDANCE AREAS - CLASS ASSIGNMENTS

Attendance Areas

The School District shall be divided into school attendance areas. The Superintendent shall review the boundary lines periodically and shall recommend any necessary changes to the Board of Education for consideration.

In general, public school pupils living in a given school attendance area shall attend that school. The Superintendent may grant an exception when the parent(s)/guardians(s) demonstrate that the student could be better accommodated by the educational program at another school, provided that the change does not have an adverse effect on the sending or receiving school.

A map of the District showing current school attendance areas shall be maintained by the Superintendent.

Assignment of Students to Classes

Assignment of students to classes shall be the responsibility of the Building Principal.

Placement in classes shall be based upon consideration of the best interests of the individual student and also the effect on the instructional setting.

The Building Principal or his or her designee shall be included in discussions regarding the placement of pupils in need of Special Education services. Special Education students shall be assigned to school programs as per their Individualized Education Program.
