

## INSTRUCTION

### EVALUATION OF STUDENTS

Evaluation shall be based upon the goals of the District as set forth in the Goals and Objectives for Instruction.

The evaluation system shall reflect available research concerning individual differences of students. Evaluation shall serve a constructive purpose in assisting the student, parent and teacher to evaluate student growth in all areas of performance and behavior.

Evaluation shall be the result of a carefully developed plan for gathering data and shall utilize a variety of instruments and devices.

Evaluation shall foster a cooperative approach between student and teacher. It shall be a method of determining student progress, and the student shall be involved and have knowledge of this ongoing process.

The student evaluation system shall further the pupils growth toward self-direction and self-responsibility.
