

## INSTRUCTION

### COMPLAINTS ABOUT CURRICULUM, INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS, AND PROGRAMS

Parents or guardians of District students shall have the right to inspect all instructional materials used in connection with any survey, analysis, or evaluation as part of any applicable program in the District. Parents, guardians and students shall be given notice of the right to inspect instructional materials at the beginning of each school year.

Parents or guardians of District students may file a formal complaint regarding the curriculum, instructional materials, or programs, using the District's Uniform Grievance Procedure, with the full expectation that they will receive a courteous and prompt reply. A parent or guardian of a District student may also request that his or her child be exempt from using a particular instructional material or program by using the District's Uniform Grievance Procedure.

Procedures for filing a complaint regarding instructional materials shall be communicated to all District staff and members of the community. The Superintendent shall develop administrative procedures relating to this policy, as necessary.
