

## INSTRUCTION

### LIBRARY RESOURCE CENTER

The Board supports the maintenance of a Library Resource Center in each building. The Library Resource Center shall serve as a multi-media center that shall provide resources to students and professional staff.

The Library Resource program will focus on enlarging and enriching the ongoing classroom instructional program. Continuous upgrading of materials and programs will be the responsibility of the principal with input from the center teacher and other teachers of each building.

Each building's collection of materials will be of a comprehensive nature, support the curriculum and provide for varied individual needs, interests, abilities and maturity levels.

Materials should be selected on the basis of encouraging the growth of knowledge and developing literary, cultural and aesthetic appreciation and ethical standards.

There should be opportunities for free selection of materials based on the student's interest as well as guided selection of materials appropriate to specific planned learning experiences.

The Board of Education will allocate funds to support the maintenance of the Library Resource Centers in such a way as to ensure equity in the collection of resources and equipment at all schools.
