

INSTRUCTION

INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS SELECTION AND ADOPTION

In addition to meeting the usual criteria for selection based on editorial quality and educational value, textbooks and other instructional materials proposed for adoption shall offer a fair representation of individuals of the various groups within our society in roles which neither demean nor misrepresent them in such a way as to create or contribute to any prejudicial views of those individuals. Such textbooks and other instructional materials should contribute to a general sense of the worth of all individuals regardless of sex, race, religion, nationality, ethnic origin, disability or other differences which may exist.

Textbooks and other instructional materials shall be adopted consistent with the provisions of the Illinois School Code.
