

INSTRUCTIONSPECIAL INSTRUCTION

Special services may be provided for those pupils who require them as a supplement to the regular educational program. Services may be available in all areas as speech development, learning development, and social/emotional adjustment.

The Superintendent shall approve the criteria for eligibility for these services, the procedures for referral and admission, and the guidelines under which the programs will operate. It will be the responsibility of the school district administrators to provide the adequate special education programs for students. The programs shall meet the standards of the Illinois State Board of Education and shall qualify for state aid where appropriate.
