The Illinois School Code provides that no student is required to take or participate in any class or course in comprehensive sex education or AIDS instruction if his or her parent(s)/guardian(s) submit written objection.

The School Code further states that the student's refusal to take or participate in a course or program on comprehensive sex education or AIDS instruction shall not be reason for suspension or expulsion of the student.

The instructional materials and course outline for the family life and sex education classes are available from the classroom teacher for your inspection. Please return the attached form to school if you wish to examine the instructional material.

You may wish to request that your child not participate in a comprehensive sex education course or an AIDS instruction class. A class attendance waiver request is enclosed for your convenience. Please return the waiver within 10 school days or I will assume that your student will attend class as usual.
