

## OPERATIONAL SERVICES

### SAFETY PROGRAM

Buildings shall be designed or modified to meet the most recent safety codes. Facilities shall be maintained in good condition in order to minimize the possibility of accidents.

To an even greater degree, however, the safety of the schools is determined by the manner which they are used. Procedures shall be developed and practices followed which will anticipate and eliminate potential hazards.

The Superintendent and the staff shall meet or exceed legal requirements for the safe operation of the schools and shall formulate and implement regulations needed to achieve a high standard of safety in school living.
