

OPERATIONAL SERVICESSAFETY PROGRAM - ACCIDENT PREVENTION

The safety of every student is a matter of serious concern at all times. School buildings and grounds should be regularly inspected for health, fire, and safety hazards. The school staff should be alert to hazardous practices or situations, especially when children are moving about within the buildings or on the playgrounds. Rules and understandings should be developed which will help reduce the chances for accidents.

Procedures shall be established for caring for a student who has suffered an accident, ranging from those requiring simple cleansing to those for which professional assistance is required. For any but minor occurrences, the parent should be contacted.
