NON-DISCRIMINATION

School District 93 shall establish and maintain an atmosphere in which all persons can develop attitudes and skills for effective, cooperative living, including:

1. Respect for the individual regardless of economic and social conditions, intellectual ability, race, ethnicity, color, language barrier, ancestry, gender identity, religion, marital status, sex, sexual orientation, or age;
2. Respect for those persons who are physically, mentally, emotionally, or perceptually handicapped;
3. Respect for cultural and religious differences;
4. Respect for economic, political, and social rights of others;
5. Respect for the right of others to seek and maintain their own identities.
