

GENERAL SCHOOL ADMINISTRATION

SUCCESSION OF AUTHORITY

If the Superintendent, Building Principal, or other administrator is temporarily absent, the succession of authority and responsibility of the respective office shall follow a succession plan developed and maintained by the Board of Education in conjunction with the Superintendent.

If the Superintendent, Building Principal, or other administrator is absent for an extraordinary length of time, the School Board President will call a School Board meeting for the Board to appoint, if necessary, an interim administrator. If a Building Principal is absent due to extended illness or leave of absence, an Assistant Principal may be assigned as acting principal for a period not to exceed 60 school days.
