

PERSONNELPROFESSIONAL PERSONNEL - CONSULTING ACTIVITIES

After application to and with the approval of the Superintendent or his or her designee, staff members may be released with full pay to serve as speakers, consultants, or resource persons outside the District. The staff member accepting such assignments shall reimburse the District for the cost of obtaining a substitute for his or her classes, up to the amount of any fee or honorarium he or she receives. The employee or the school district or institution receiving such services may assume responsibility for travel, lodging, and meal expenses and for substitute costs if any are incurred.

Any consulting, professional development, or other professional involvement activity shall be undertaken with the understanding that such activity shall not interfere with the staff member's responsibilities to the District and that anyone engaging in such activities shall speak as an individual unless specifically directed by the Board to speak as a representative of the District.
