# Dear Community Member,



As the 2022-23 school year comes to a close for our 3,350 preschool, elementary and middle school students, and our 8th graders prepare to graduate on to high school, please take a moment to review the important updates from Community Consolidated School District 93 (CCSD93) included within this newsletter.

CCSD93 Students Outperforming Growth Expectations

CCSD93 partners with student achievement data analysts ECRA to examine standardized test results to measure whether students are lagging behind, meeting or outperforming their personal projected growth based on their own past educational performance. I am extremely pleased to share that the analysis of 2022-23 winter test results shows that 89% of our students are meeting or outperforming their personal math growth projections and 86% of our students are meeting or outperforming their personal reading growth projections. This represents 5% more students meeting or outperforming their math projections than would be expected by statistical models for student achievement, and 2% more doing so in reading. These results are due to the hard work and dedication of our educators, the commitment of our students, and the support of their families and our community.

#### Mission Statement & Tagline

A mission statement describes the essential purpose of an organization. CCSD93's existing mission statement was reviewed and analyzed. It was determined that it still encompasses just what the community wants for CCSD93's students. CCSD93's mission remains: Maximize the academic, social & emotional potential of each student.

CCSD93 has introduced a tagline, a brief, memorable, repeatable phrase that succinctly and clearly communicates what an organization does that makes it unique. **CCSD93's tagline is:** Maximize the potential.

#### Core Values

Core values are traits or qualities that represent an organization's deeply held beliefs and fundamental driving forces. They are what's most important to an organization. CCSD93's core values are:

- Students are at the heart of all we do.
- All students can learn, grow and meet high expectations.
- Educators working collaboratively, using data, make an impact.
- Shared leadership and responsibility are essential.
- Strong, respectful and supportive relationships lead to success.

#### **Key Performance Indicators**

Key performance indicators (KPIs) measure the progress toward achieving the strategic priorities and objectives described to the right. CCSD93 worked with ECRA, its student achievement data analysts, to identify KPIs, which will be tracked publicly on a district level Strategic Dashboard and updated annually for the community to see. Data disaggregated by building, grade level, and/or student groups will be reviewed by CCSD93's educators, as appropriate.
